This course is designed for advanced ESL students who enjoy reading literature and would like to learn more about contemporary Canadian and American 20<sup>th</sup> Century writers. Each week we will look at a different short story. Students are expected to read a new story each week as homework and come to class prepared to engage in class and group discussions. By reading literature, students can expand their thinking, develop important critical thinking and analytical skills and build up their vocabulary. By discussing in class they can improve their speaking and communication skills.
